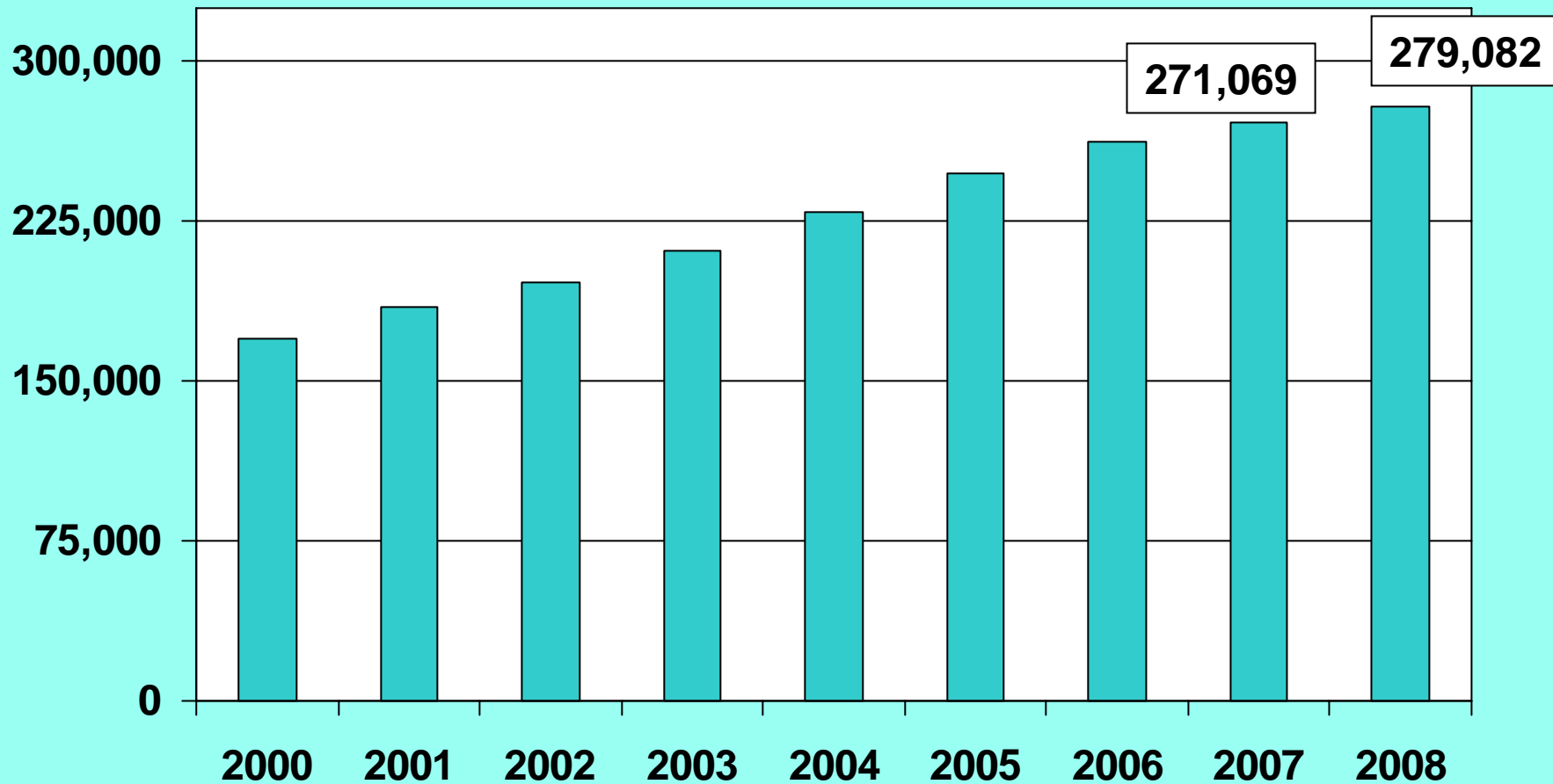

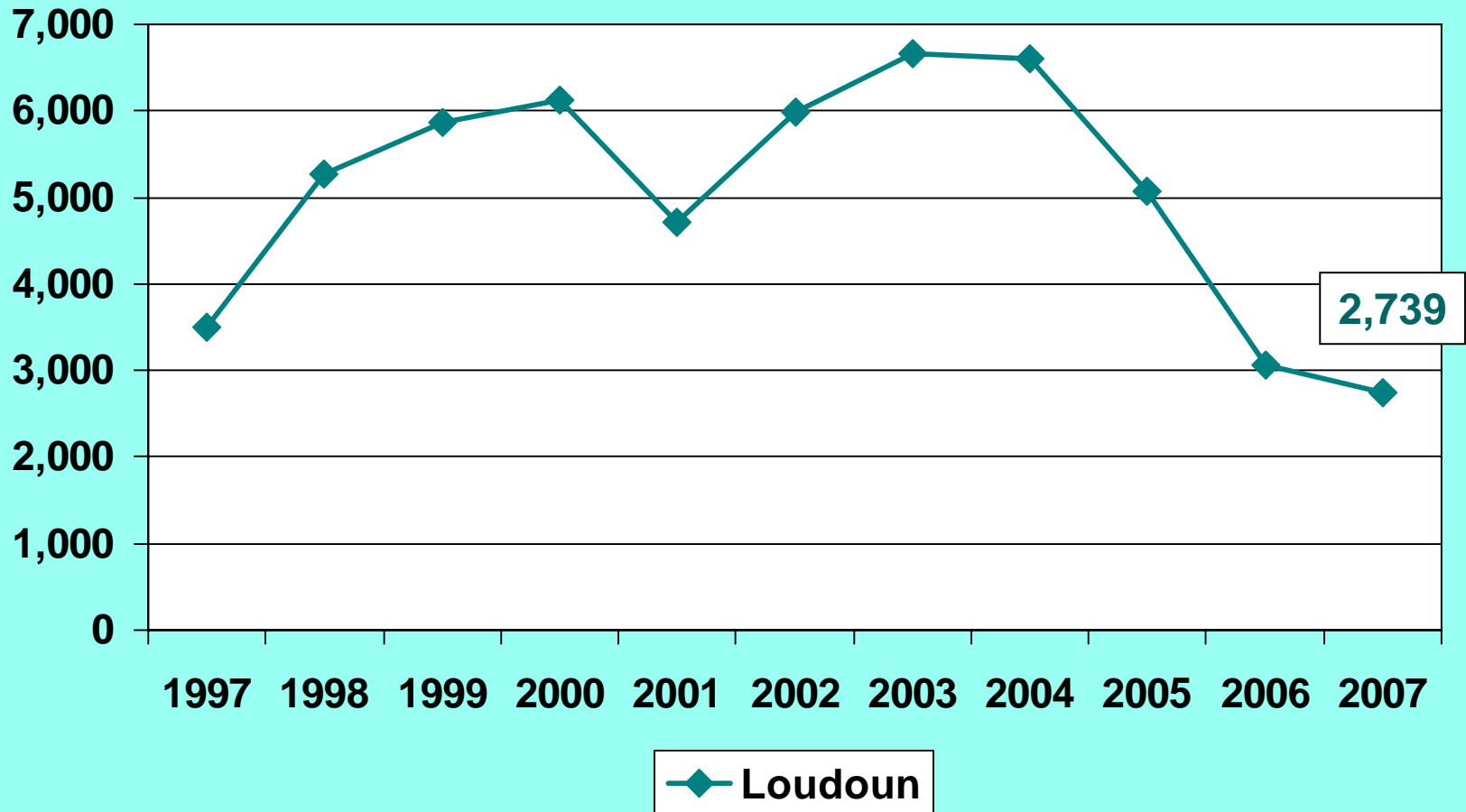

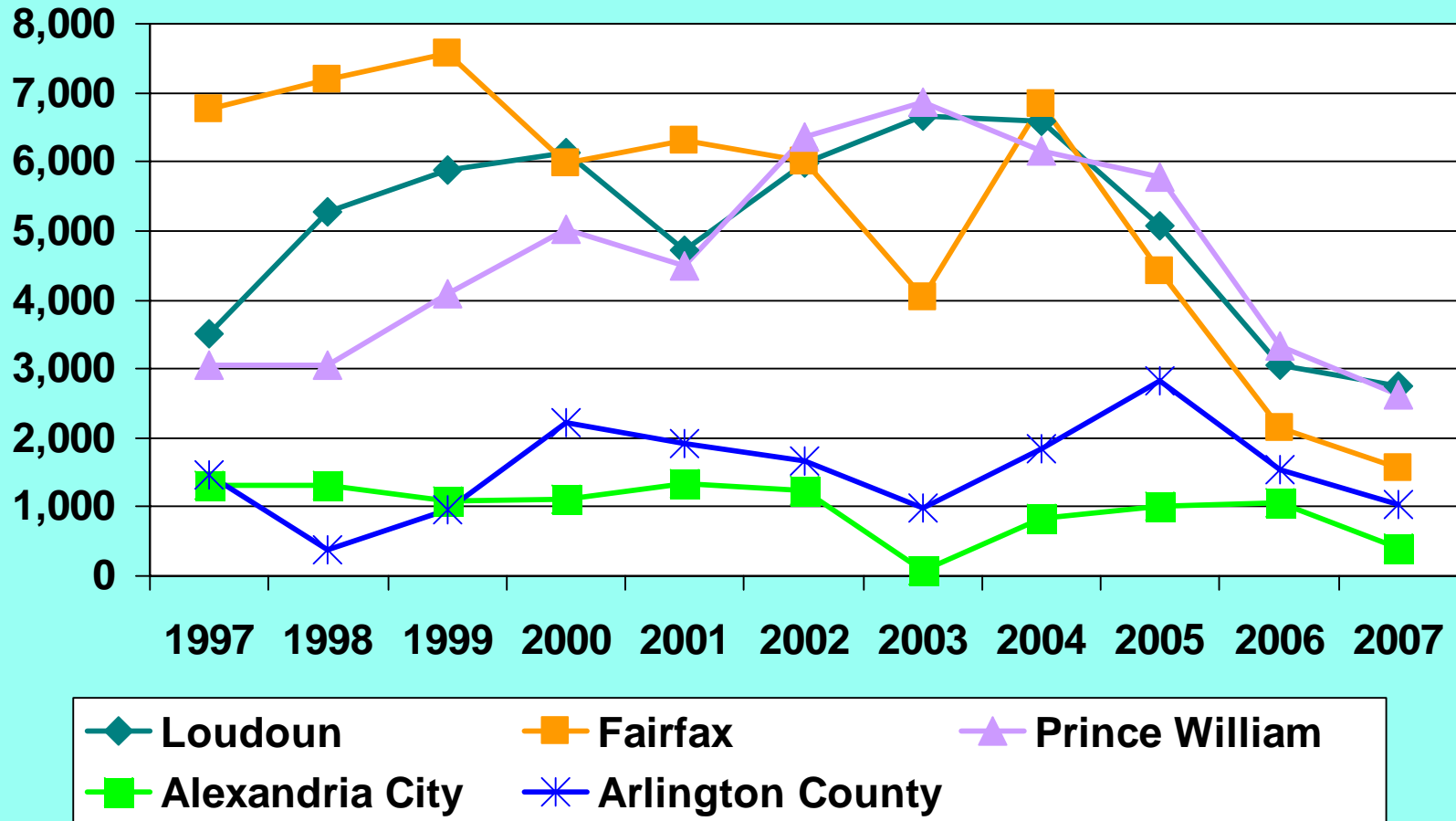


Residential Building Permit Trends



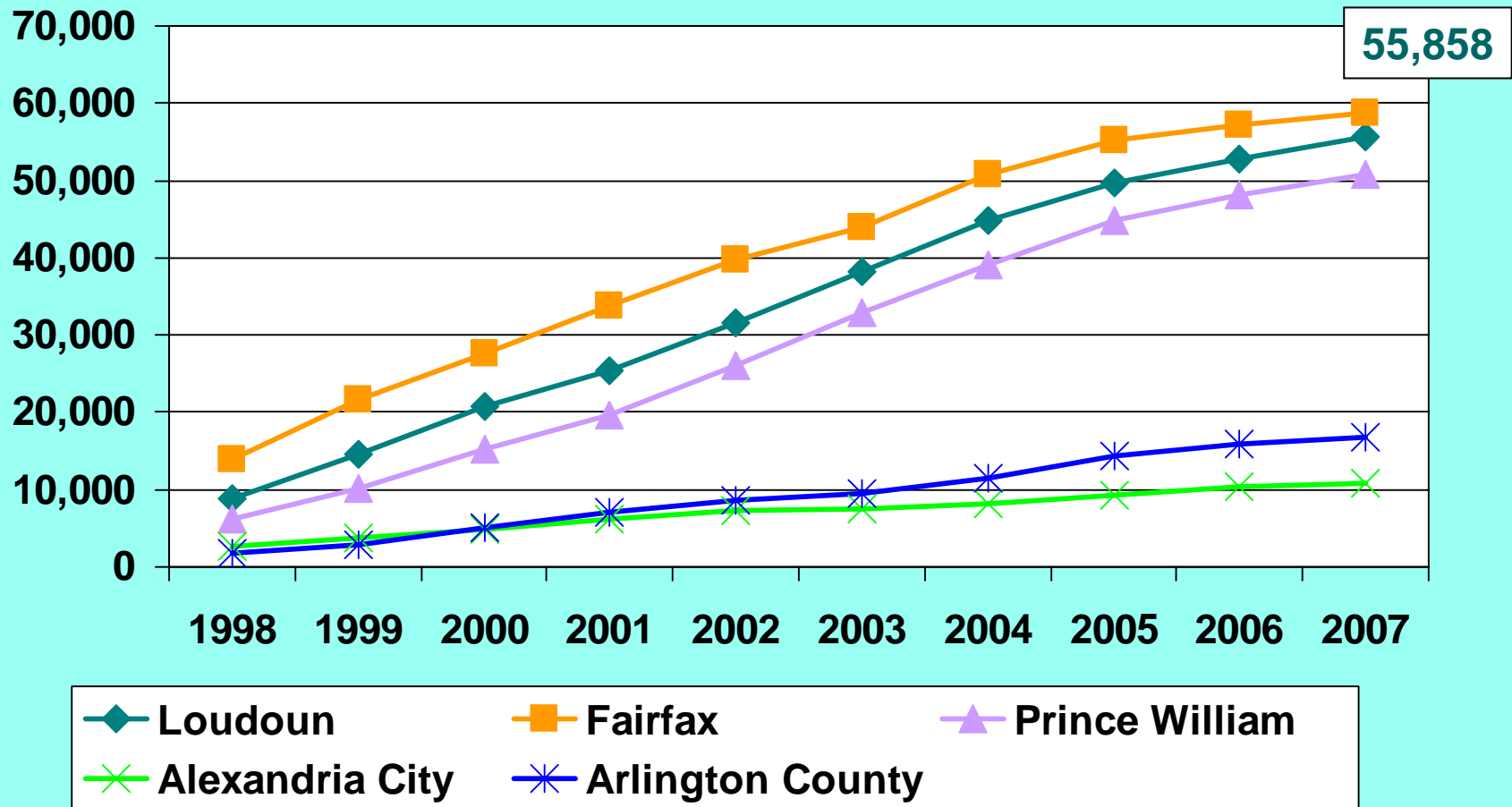

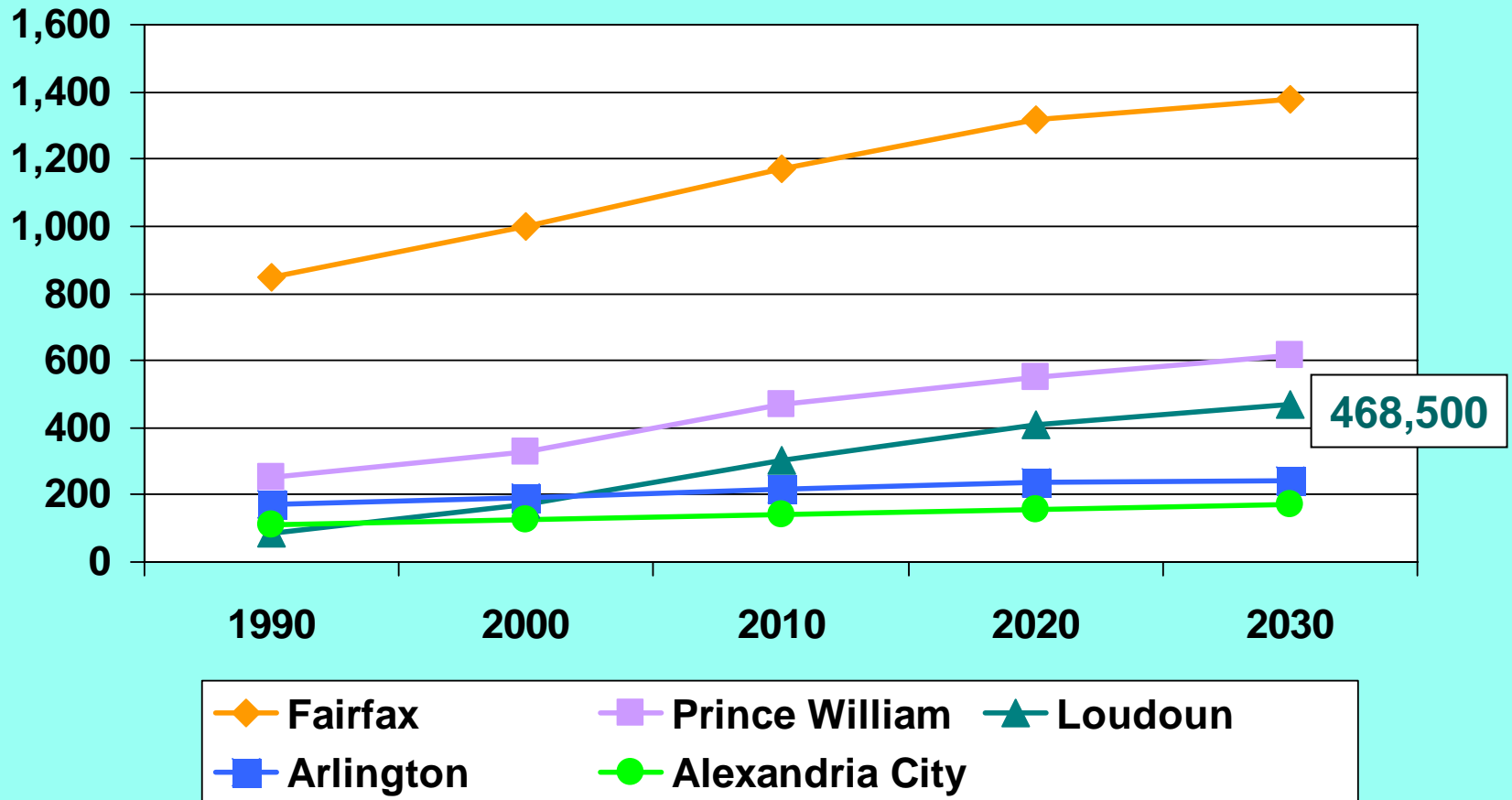
Cumulative Residential Building Permits

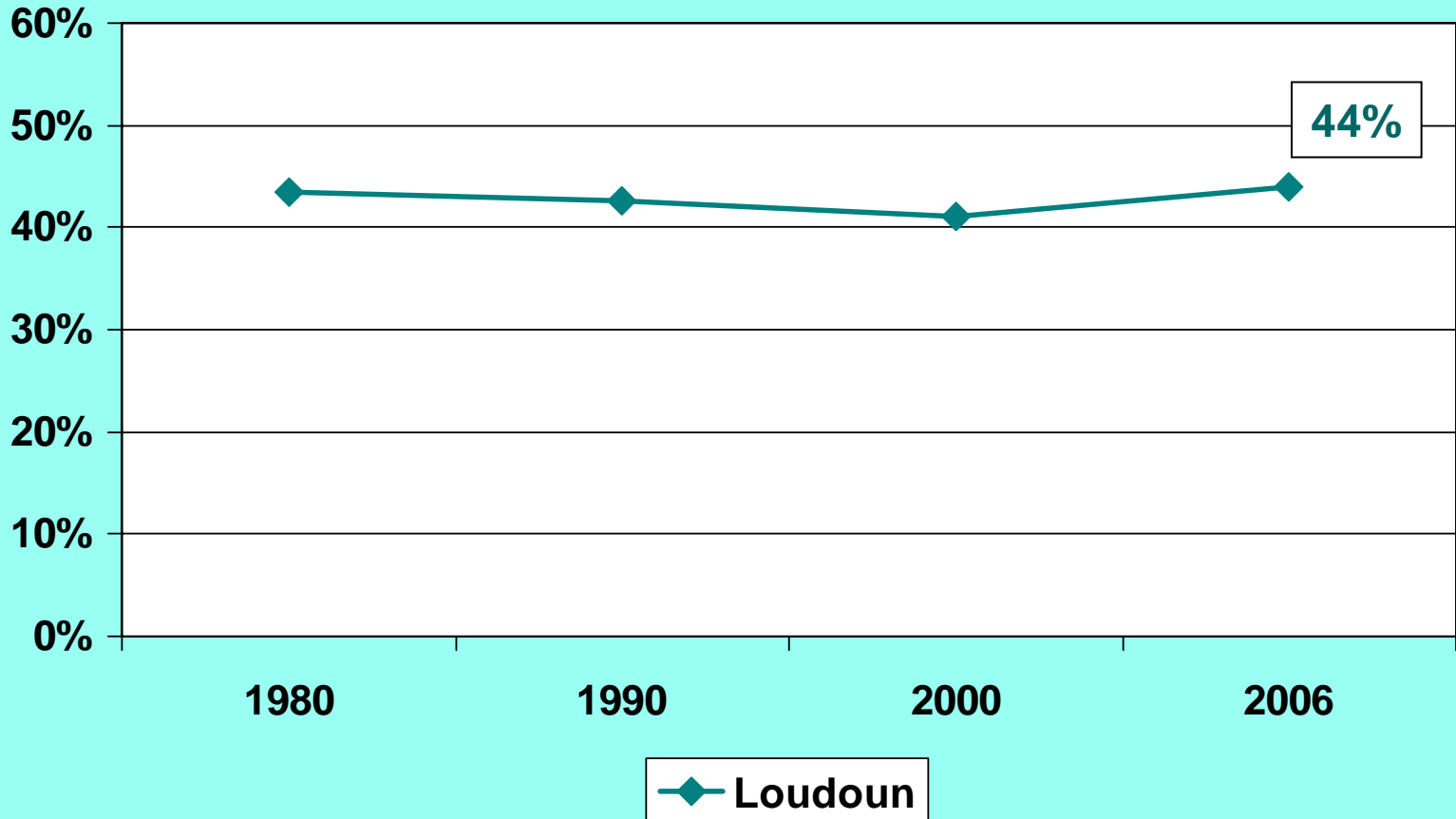


Northern Virginia Major Counties Population Forecasts



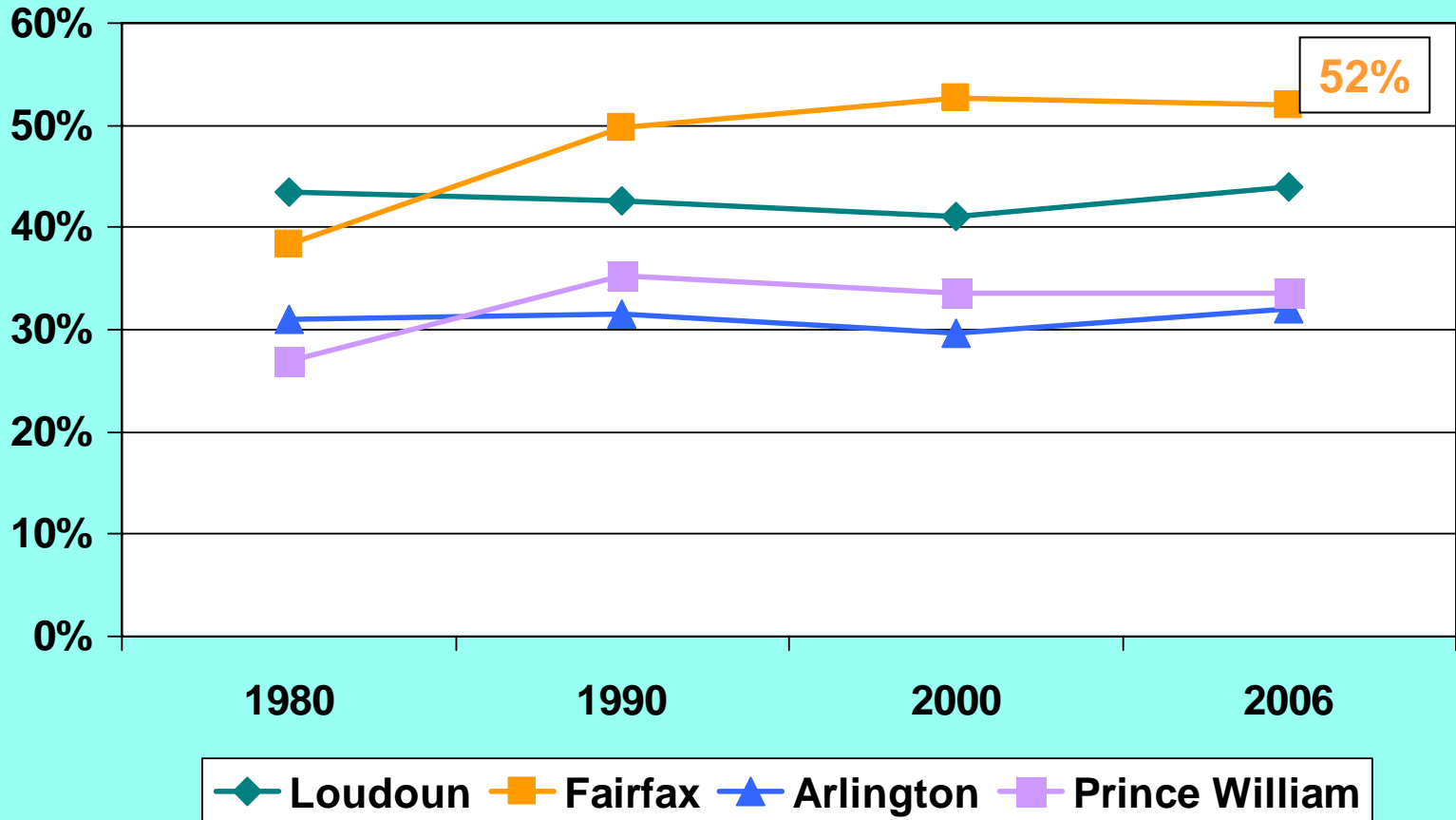


Commuting Patterns – % of Loudoun Residents Working in Loudoun



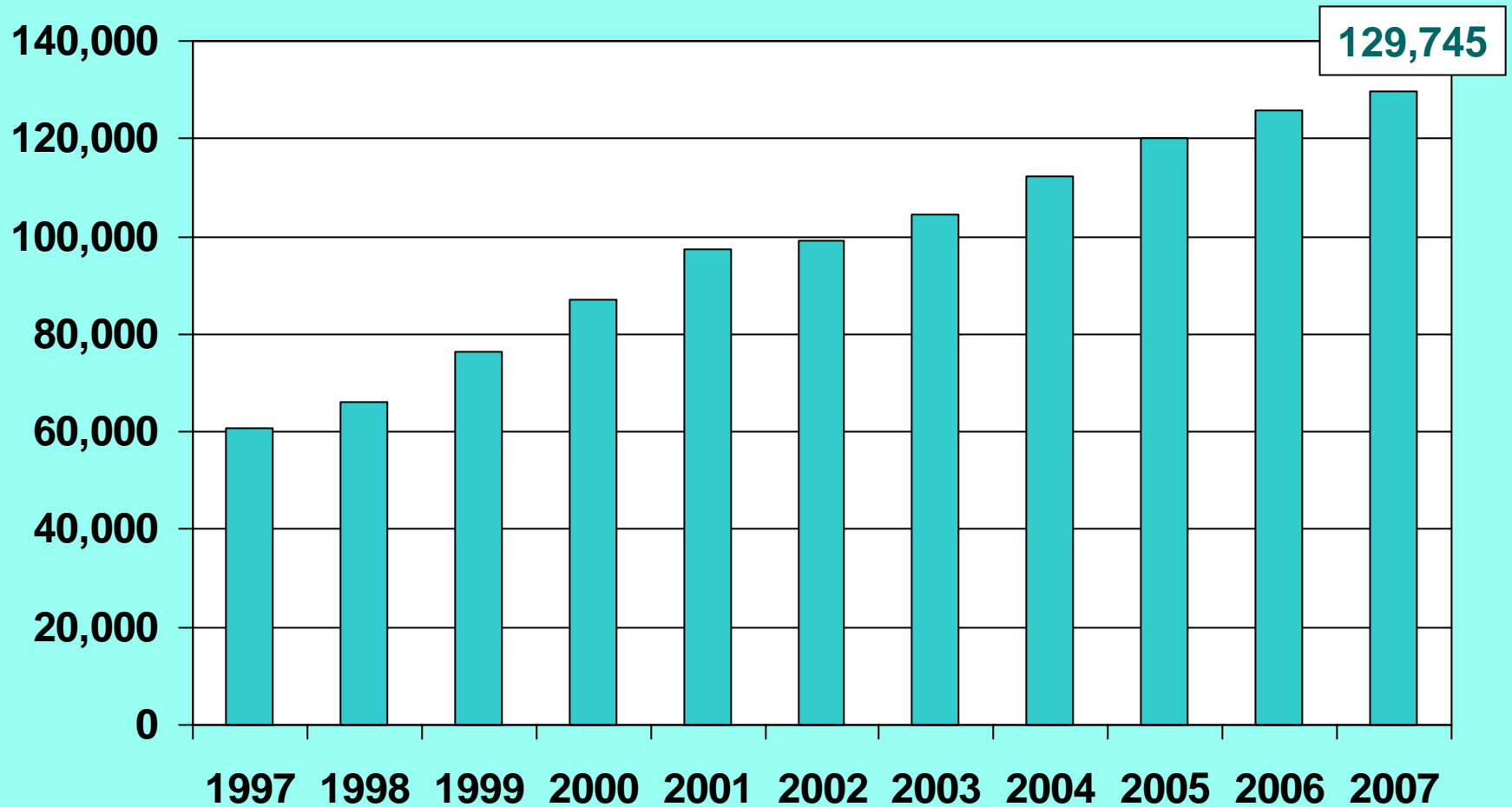


Commuting Patterns – % of County Residents working in their County

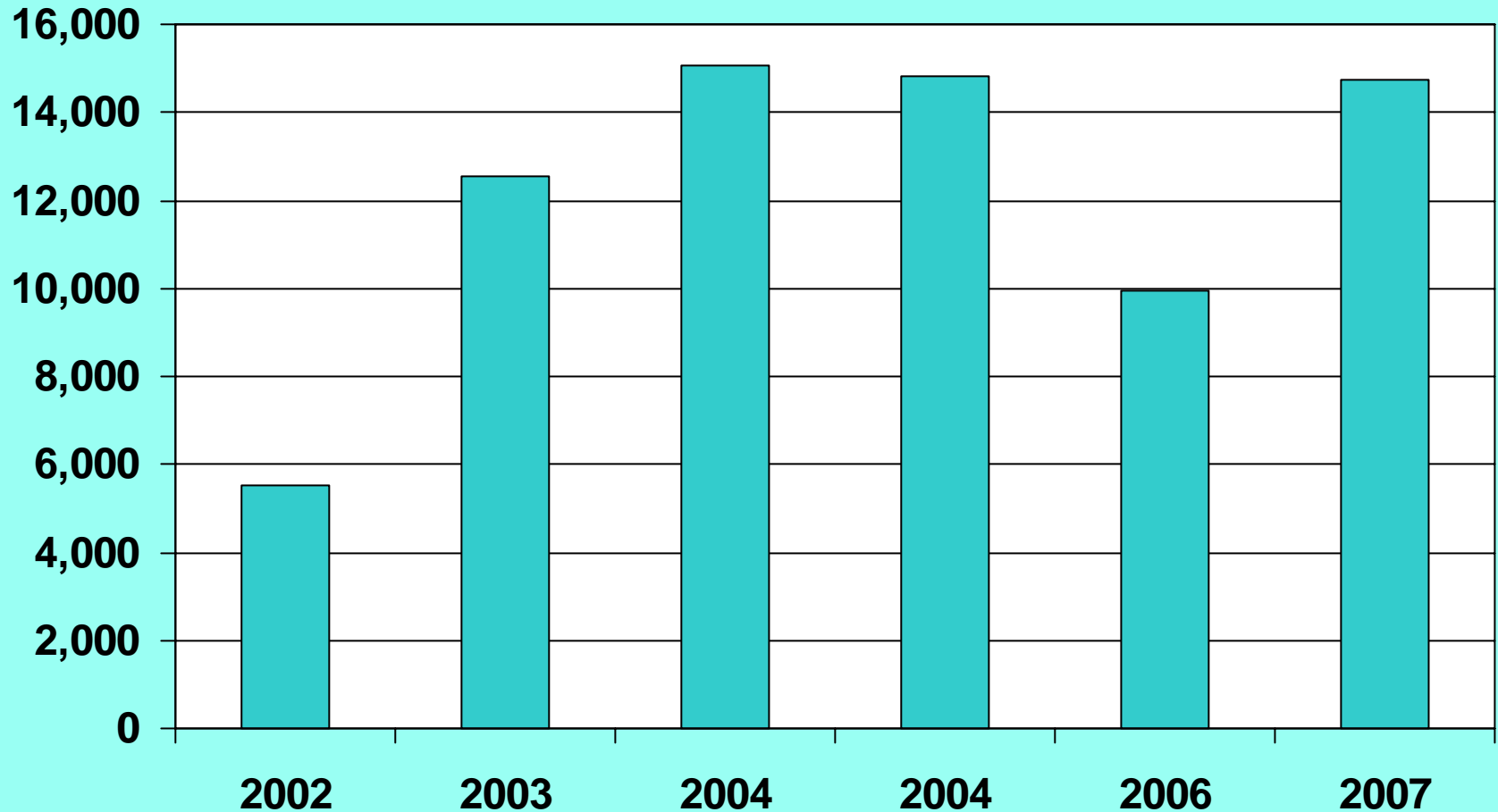

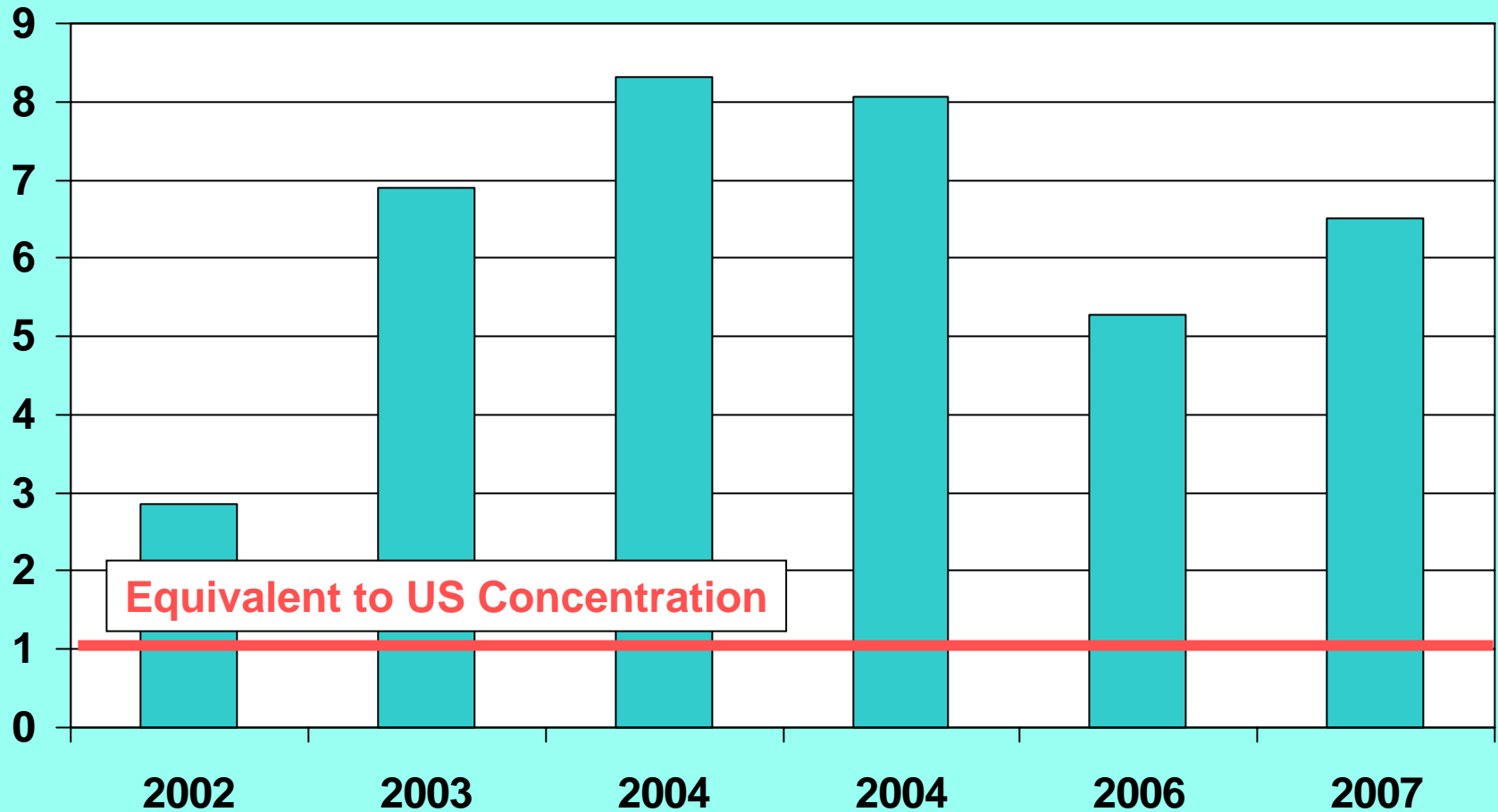
Information & Communication Technology (ICT) Employment Trends

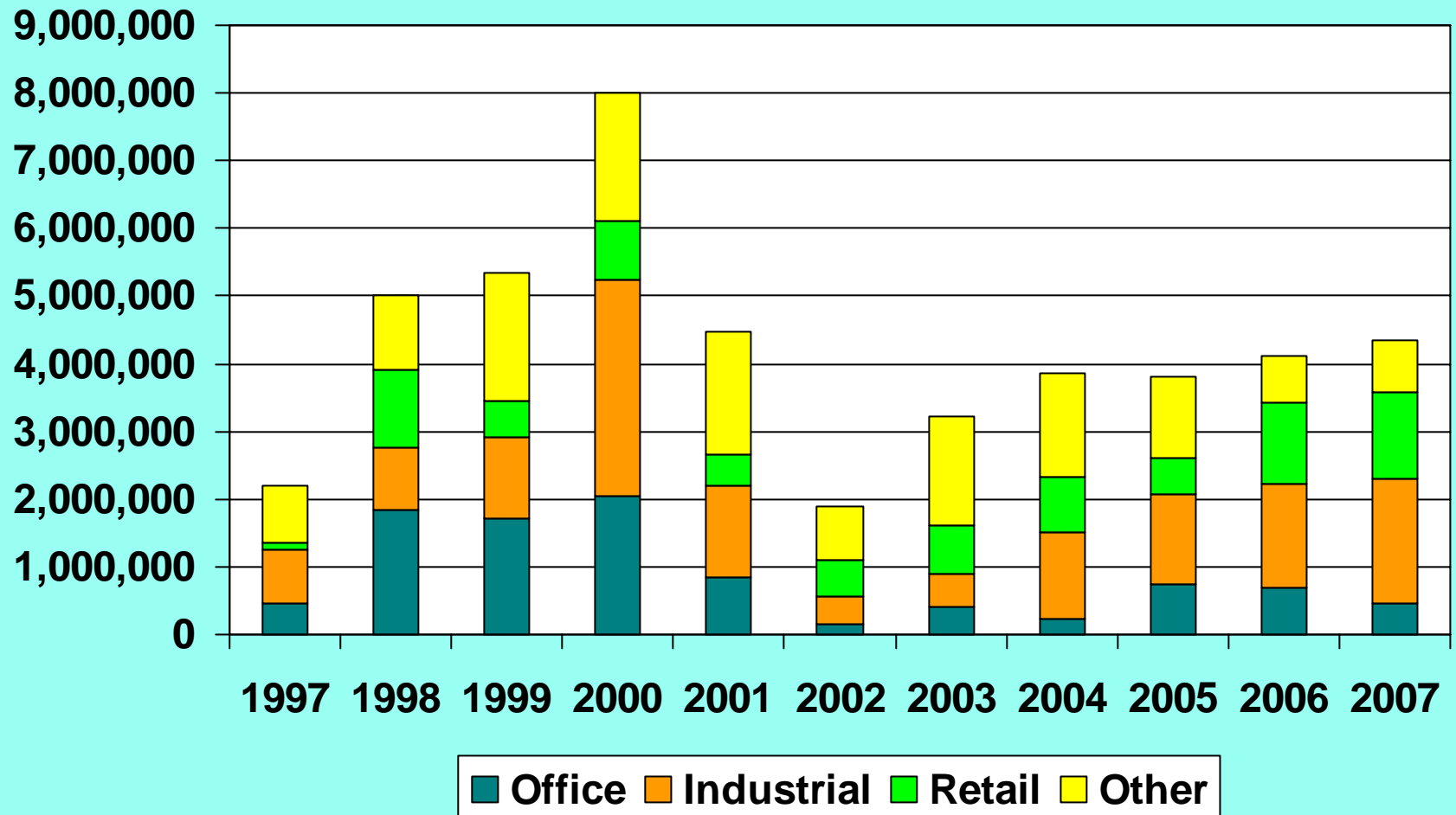


ICT Location Quotient



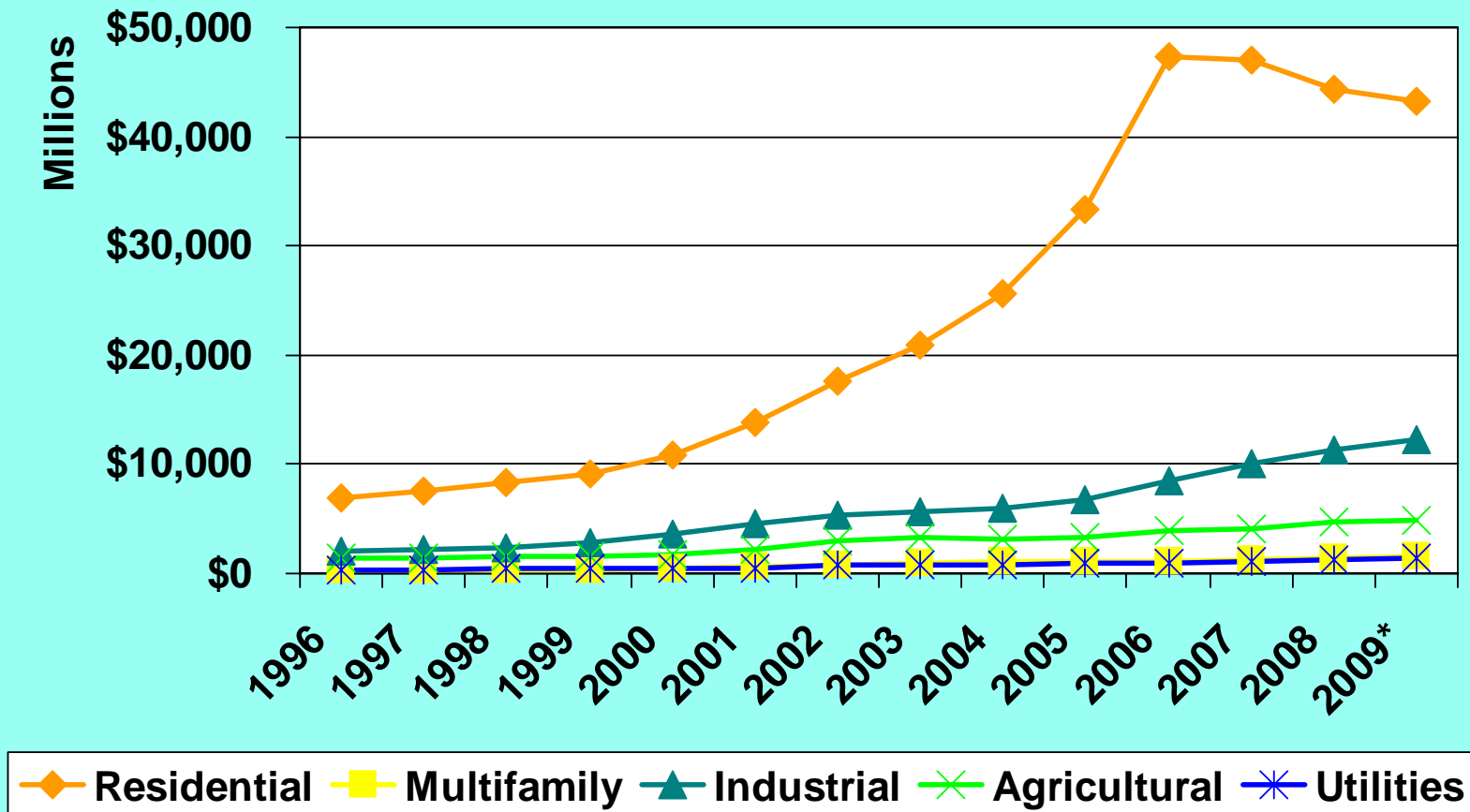


Loudoun County Non-Residential Square Footage Permitted
